

TREATS

High fiber fruits are the best choice:

Sugar can upset the micro-organism balance in the cecum so try these in limited quantities:

- Apples (NOT the seeds – they are toxic)
- Pears
- Nectarines
- Peaches
- Papaya
- Strawberries
- Raspberries
- Bananas and grapes (very limited amounts – they are very high in sugar)
- Pineapple (some varieties are too acidic and will burn mouth tissues)

DO NOT Give Your Rabbit These:

- Human treats or candies
- Cereals
- Nuts
- Breads
- Chocolate
- Grains like crackers or pasta
- Pet store treats or chews full of dried corn, sugar, etc.

All About Chewing:

- Try apple branches to give your rabbits something they can really get their teeth into . . . they love chewing and apple branches are safe.
- Pinecones that have been cleaned and baked from rabbit suppliers are suitable for chewing.
- Many woods are toxic to rabbits so be careful!
- Untreated willow baskets, and chew blocks from the pet store are okay, too!
- Timothy hay cubes and apple/timothy cubes available from Oxbow Hay and American Pet Diner for chewing.
